

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### LOCATIONS:

**Alliance Stage** – Our 770-seat theatre, located in the Robert W. Woodruff Arts Center at the corner of Peachtree Street and 15th Street in Midtown Atlanta.

**Hertz Stage** – Our 200-seat theatre, also located in the Robert W. Woodruff Arts Center.

**Parking:** Buses park for free on 15th, 16th or Arts Center Way for the Alliance Stage or on Juniper St. near the 14th Street Playhouse. Buses may load and unload on Peachtree, but **THERE IS NO PARKING ON PEACHTREE STREET.** This is a change from previous years. Car parking is available at an hourly rate at area parking lots.

**Study Guides:** Study guides are designed to help you prepare your students for their theatrical experience and are sent approximately one month prior to the performance.

**Seating:** Seating is assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis, as directed by the theatre staff. Please notify us in advance if you have students requiring wheelchair seating, hearing assistance devices or other special needs.

**Accessibility Services:** All venues have wheelchair seating. The Alliance Stage is equipped with an Infrared Ear hearing assistance system.

**Lunch and Picnic Opportunities:** The Woodruff Arts Center has space available for school groups to eat lunch prior to or following a performance at the Alliance Theatre. Reservations must be made in advance to ensure space and are subject to availability. Students may not bring food or beverages into any performance.

**Etiquette:** Schools are asked to instruct their students in proper theatre etiquette before attending the theatre and to be sure that they have an adequate number

of chaperones spread among the students to help monitor student behavior. We strongly recommend a minimum of one chaperone per 20 students. Schools not displaying proper theatre etiquette as outlined in the study guide may be asked to leave the performance without a refund.
