Reservations: Call **404.733.4660** or e-mail allianceschoolday@woodruffcenter.org. All schools must make a reservation in advance, so call early to avoid disappointment.

Tickets: Tickets for school groups of any size and home school groups of 10 or more are \$6.50 per student. Every 20th ticket is free for the use of a teacher or chaperone. Additional teachers, parents and other chaperones are \$8.00 each. Tickets for home school groups of less than 10 are \$8.00 per person.

Post-Show Talkbacks and Backstage Tours: Post-show talkbacks give students the opportunity to ask questions to actors and theatre staff. They are available following select 11:45 a.m. performances with reservations only. For groups of 75 or less, backstage tours are available following select 11:45 a.m. performances of *Goodnight Moon* and *Class of 3000 LIVE*. Reservations for talkbacks or tours must be made at least two weeks in advance and are subject to availability.
